OVERVIEW:

House Bill 1551 amends the Act of October 9, 2008 (P.L. 1363, No. 100) known as the Crane Operator Licensure Act, to change the effective date for Section 506(a) regarding license without certification. The State Board of Crane Operators does not yet have implementing regulations and cannot issue any licenses until these regulations are promulgated. Act 100, as it is currently written, would end the grandfathering period before the Board's expected date of operation. This bill would extend the grandfathering period until December 9, 2011.

ANALYSIS:

The bill only extends the grandfathering period for obtaining a crane operator license and does not have an adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
