OVERVIEW:

House Bill 1616 amends the Non-controlled Substance Reporting and Registration Act of 1990, which requires individuals engaging in the sale, distribution, transfer or furnishing of substances listed in the act to register with the Pennsylvania Department of Health. The bill adds dextromethorphan to the list of substances which require reporting.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.

The Department of Health would not incur any additional costs as a result of this legislation.
