OVERVIEW:

House Bill 1702 appropriates funds to the Lake Erie College of Osteopathic Medicine for 2009/10.

This act will take effect on July 1, 2009 or immediately, whichever is later.

ANALYSIS:

This funding reflects the Governor's 2009/10 budget request. The bill makes one appropriation as follows:

\$1,661,000 Instruction in the Doctor of Osteopathy program

This represents an \$185,000 decrease, or 10% from the previous fiscal year.
