OVERVIEW:

House Bill 1710 appropriates funds to Temple University

This act will take effect on July 1, 2009 or immediately, whichever is later.

ANALYSIS:

This funding reflects the Governor's 2009/10 budget request. The bill makes the following appropriations:

\$164,974,000 for general support
\$10,530,000 in Federal ARRA fiscal stabilization (stimulus) funds

With both state and federal funds, total appropriations to the university come to \$175,504,000.
