OVERVIEW:

House Bill 1711 appropriates funds to the University of Pittsburgh.

This act will take effect on July 1, 2009 or immediately, whichever is later.

ANALYSIS:

This funding reflects the Governor's 2009/10 budget request. The bill makes the following appropriations:

\$160,490,000

for general support

\$10,244,000

in federal ARRA fiscal stabilization (stimulus) funds

With both state and federal funds, total appropriations to the university come to \$170,734,000.
