OVERVIEW:

House Bill 1774 adds Section 358 to the Insurance Company Law of 1921, which specifies that service contracts shall not be construed to be the business of insurance and thus excluded from regulation. The bill also defines "service contract" for the purposes of this exclusion provision.

The act shall take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

Enactment of House Bill 1774 would not impact commonwealth funds.
