*This cost is not significant enough to require an increase in any appropriation to PennDOT.

OVERVIEW:

This bill designates the bridge located on Route 2033 over Jack's Run Stream, White Oak Borough, Allegheny County, as the *Milton L. Lebowitz Memorial Bridge* and requires the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) to erect and maintain appropriate signs in both directions on the designated bridge.

The effective date is sixty days.

ANALYSIS:

According to PennDOT, it costs about \$1,000 to post signs designating a bridge. These signs last typically twelve to fifteen years before they need to be replaced. This cost will be funded out of the Motor License Fund from the appropriation to the department for state highway maintenance. The General Appropriation Act of 2008 (Act No. 38A) provided \$809,000,000 for this line item for FY 2008/09, and the Governor has proposed \$775,339,000 for this line item for FY 2009/10.

This cost is not significant enough to affect adversely PennDOT's budget.
