OVERVIEW:

House Bill 2044 amends the Unfair Trade Practices and Consumer Protection Law regarding private action by increasing the amount for which a person can sue for from \$100 to \$500. Under this legislation, a person may now sue in a private action for actual damages or \$500 whichever is greater.

This act shall take effect immediately.

ANALYSIS:

The enactment of House Bill 2044 is not expected to have an adverse fiscal impact on the Commonwealth.
