OVERVIEW:

House Bill 2172 amends Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) to further provide for jurisdictional money limits in cases heard by magisterial district judges (MDJ) and Philadelphia Municipal Court (PMC).

The limit for PMC would increase from \$10,000 to \$12,000 and the limit for MDJ would increase from \$8,000 to \$12,000.

This act takes effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

According to the Administrative Office of Pennsylvania Courts, the Judiciary does not foresee any quantifiable costs if House Bill 2172 is enacted.
