OVERVIEW:

House Bill 2271 amends Title 65 (Public Officers) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for mailings by members of General Assembly. A member cannot spend appropriated funds on mass mailings that are mailed 60 days prior to an election candidate.

The bill takes effect 60 days after enactment.

ANALYSIS:

The bill has no costs. It is a policy decision. The legislation will place in law a portion of current House Rule 14. The law would apply to Senate and House members.
