OVERVIEW:

House Bill 2281 appropriates a total of \$46,873,000 from restricted revenue accounts in the General fund to the Department of State for use by the Bureau of Professional and Occupational Affairs in support of the professional licensure boards and the State Athletic Commission.

This act shall take effect July 1, 2010 or immediately, whichever is later.

ANALYSIS:

The bill makes appropriations for FY 2010/11 as recommended by the Governor for the Bureau of Professional and Occupational Affairs, the State Board of Medicine, the State Board of Osteopathic Medicine, the State Board of Podiatry and the State Athletic Commission
