OVERVIEW:

House Bill 2292 makes appropriations to the Pennsylvania State University for FY 2010/11. Appropriations include both state funds and federal ARRA funds.

This bill takes effect July 1, 2010 or immediately, whichever is later.

ANALYSIS:

The bill appropriates \$304,449,000 in state funds to the University for general support and \$13,623,000 for the Pennsylvania College of Technology. In addition, the bill appropriates \$15,115,000 in federal ARRA fiscal stabilization funds to the University and \$676,000 to the Pennsylvania College of Technology. In total, the combined state and federal support is equal to \$333,863,000.

These totals are equal to the amount appropriated to the University in the 2009/10 fiscal year.

Payments to the Pennsylvania State University from the appropriation will be made monthly during the course of the fiscal year.
