OVERVIEW:

House Bill 2294 makes appropriations to Temple University for FY 2010/11. Appropriations include both state funds and federal ARRA funds.

This bill takes effect July 1, 2010 or immediately, whichever is later.

ANALYSIS:

This bill appropriates \$164,974,000 in state funds to the University for general support and \$7,763,000 in federal ARRA fiscal stabilization funds. In total, the combined state and federal support is equal to \$172,737,000.

These totals are equal to the amount appropriated to the University for the 2009/10 fiscal year.

Payments to Temple University from the appropriation will be made monthly during the course of the fiscal year.
