OVERVIEW:

House Bill 2352 amends the Third Class City Code to provide for the office of city administrator or manager. City councils may vote to create the office and appoint a person to fill it. The city administrator or manager serves at the pleasure of the council, but the council may enter into an employment agreement with the manager. The length of the agreement may be up to two years, but ends on the first organizational meeting of the council following an election

The bill will take effect in sixty days

ANALYSIS:

Many other types of municipalities already have city managers permitted under their controlling statute. Allowing third class cities to establish the position will not have any fiscal impact to the commonwealth.
