OVERVIEW:

House Bill 2355 amends the act of June 24, 1931, known as the First Class Township Code to add language concerning employment agreements with a township manager.

The bill will take effect in sixty days.

ANALYSIS:

The bill adds language to the First Class Township Code stipulating that the township manager serves at the pleasure of the board of commissioners, subject to contractual rights from an employment agreement.

The bill also adds language regarding employment agreements with the township manager. Agreements may last a maximum of two years and cannot run for longer than the term of the board of commisioners. Agreements also may not guarantee employment for the term of the agreement.

The changes made by the bill to the position of township manager will have no fiscal impact to the commonwealth.
