OVERVIEW:

House Bill 2357 is an annual Executive proclamation to designate March 30th of each year as "Welcome Home Vietnam Veterans Day."

The bill takes effect immediately after enactment.

ANALYSIS:

The bill has no costs. Each year, a resolution is passed to designate/recognize this important day in our history. A U.S. Resolution was passed in March of 2010 to encourage communities across the nations to establish March 30th as such. This bill will require Governor to issue "... annually a proclamation calling upon all public schools and educational institutions to observe "Welcome Home Vietnam Veterans Day" and to conduct exercises recognizing the contributions of all those involved in the Vietnam Conflict and remembering the sacrifices they made for their country."
