OVERVIEW:

House Bill 2342 authorizes the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, with the approval of the Governor, to grant and convey:

- 0.57 acres of land, free of any Project 70 restrictions, located in Stewart Township, Fayette County to Stewart Township in exchange for the conveyance of 0.57 acres of land currently owned by Stewart Township, subject to Project 70 restrictions by DCNR, to the Commonwealth for the purposes of relocating a Township Road; and
- 0.27 acres of land located in Stewart Township, Fayette County to Stewart Township in exchange for the conveyance of a 0.001 acre of land currently owned by Fayette County to the Commonwealth for the purposes of relocating a County bridge.

The bill also reserves a drainage easement for Stewart Township and prohibits any use of the properties for a licensed gaming facility.

In the event the conveyance authorized by this bill is not executed within 12 months of the effective date, the authorization contained in the bill shall become null and void.

This act shall take effect immediately.

ANALYSIS:

The bill provides that all costs and fees incidental to the conveyances in this legislation shall be borne by Stewart Township; therefore, enactment of this legislation should have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
