OVERVIEW:

House Bill 2365 amends the act of December 12, 1986 (P.L.1559, No.169), known as the Whistleblower Law, further providing for the definition of "public body."

The bill takes effect 60 days after enactment.

ANALYSIS:

The bill has no fiscal year costs. This legislation is a policy decision that extends the existing whistle blower protection to employees of the General Assembly and its agencies.
