OVERVIEW:

House Bill 2445 amends Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) by providing that a senior judge or retired justice may administer oaths in the Commonwealth so long as certain criteria are met.

This act takes effect in 60 days.

According to the Administrative Office of Pennsylvania Courts, the Judiciary does not foresee any quantifiable costs if House Bill 2445 is enacted.
