OVERVIEW:

House Bill 2489 amends Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) by further providing for magisterial district judges contempt orders. Under this bill, those who defy an order for fingerprinting may be punished by judges for criminal contempt.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

According to the Administrative Office of Pennsylvania Courts, the enactment of this bill will not have an adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
