OVERVIEW:

HB 2521 is a freestanding act which requires health care providers who order but do not perform a component of an anatomic pathology service to disclose additional information in the billing statement.

The bill will take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

Violations of the provisions of the bill would be punishable by non-payment of the bill, and also by action of the applicable licensure board. The Department of State reports that adding this violation to the list of grounds for disciplinary action for licensure boards will not have any further cost to the commonwealth, as the various boards already have the framework in place to carry out the provision of the act.
