**OVERVIEW:**

Senate Bill 1036 is the nonpreferred appropriation for the University of Pittsburgh for 2009/10.

This bill takes effect immediately.

**ANALYSIS:**

The bill appropriates \$160,490,000 in state funds for 2009/10 for general support. It also appropriates \$7,505,000 in Federal ARRA Fiscal Stabilization Funds to supplement the state amount.

In addition to the appropriations for 2009/10, the bill also contains a Federal supplemental appropriation for 2008/09 in the amount of \$8,644,000
