OVERVIEW:

Senate Bill 1039 is a nonpreferred appropriation bill for the University of Pennsylvania for FY 2009/10 for veterinary activities and the University of Pennsylvania Museum.

This bill takes effect immediately.

ANALYSIS:

The bill appropriates \$34,419,000 for veterinary activities and \$113,000 for the University of Pennsylvania Museum. Payments to the University for both veterinary activities and the museum shall be made quarterly.
