OVERVIEW:

Senate Bill 1104 appropriates \$186,000 to the Burn Foundation located in Philadelphia. Payment of this appropriation shall be made by the Secretary of Health in equal quarterly payments.

The act shall take effect immediately.

The bill appropriates \$186,000 to the Burn Foundation for outpatient and inpatient treatment in 2009/10.
