**OVERVIEW:**

Senate Bill 1105 appropriates \$431,000 to the Children's Institute located in Pittsburgh. Payment of this appropriation shall be made by the Secretary of Health in equal quarterly payments.

The act shall take effect immediately.

**ANALYSIS:**

The bill appropriates \$431,000 to the Children's Institute for the treatment and rehabilitation of children and young adults with disabling diseases in 2009/10.
