**SUMMARY:** Designates Pickertown Road Bridge over U.S. Route 202 Parkway in Warrington Township, Bucks County, as the Robert V. Cotton Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation would designate Pickertown Road Bridge carrying Pickertown Road over the U.S. Route 202 Parkway in Warrington Township, Bucks County, as the Robert V. Cotton Bridge.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying this designation at each end of the bridge.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
