**SUMMARY**: Amends the Vehicle Code to provide specialty license plates for motor homes and motorcycles. This legislation would take effect in 120 days.

**ANALYSIS**: This legislation would amend Section 1341 (Special registration plates generally) of the Vehicle Code to add motor homes of any weight and motorcycles to the list of vehicles that can qualify for specialty license plates such as vanity tags and special organization plates. It also changes the weight limit up to 14,000 pounds on a passenger car or truck for personal and special organization registration plates.

This legislation also reorganizes the section on Special Registration Plates separating personal (vanity) registration plates from organization registration plates. Separating the two plates is more for clarification purposes, but will continue to allow motorcycle owners to get personal registration plates.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
