**SUMMARY:** This legislation increases to 14,000 pounds the maximum registered gross weight limit for passenger vehicles and trucks eligible to be issued special registration plates. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation would increase from 10,000 pounds to 14,000 pounds the registered gross weight limit for passenger vehicles, recreational motor vehicles, motorcycles, trucks, farm vehicles, or antique, classic and collectible vehicles eligible to be issued special registration plates. The legislation will extend that increased weight limit to the issuance of all special registration plates, as well as to those individuals applying for seasonal vehicle registration, and individuals applying for a "person with disability" special license plate.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** This legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
