SUMMARY:

This legislation amends Title 18, Crimes and Offenses, by adding a definition for Private Residential Rehabilitative Institutions (PRRIs), and adding them to the sections relating to aggravated assault and criminal trespass.

ANALYSIS:

This bill provides the same protection from assault to PRRI staff as is currently provided to other protected classes, such as public school teachers. It also expands the scope of criminal trespass to include PRRI grounds.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The enactment of this legislation may increase costs to the Commonwealth to the extent that individuals violate these expanded aggravated assault and criminal trespass provisions. No reliable data exist on how many individuals that may be. However, it is not expected to be number large enough to have a significant impact on Commonwealth funds.
