SUMMARY: Creates the PA Gaming Control Board Membership Restriction Act. This bill would take effect immediately.

ANALYSIS: This legislation would limit the appointment of members of the Senate and House of Representatives or an executive-level public employee to the PA Gaming Control Board (PGCB). The bill would restrict a member of the Senate or the House of Representatives or an executive-level public employee from being appointed to the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board during the term of office for which the person was elected or for the period of employment and for a period of 12 months thereafter.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation would have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
