SUMMARY: House Bill 529 amends the Crimes Code by adding a section concerning false caller identification information display.

ANALYSIS: This legislation makes the act of purposely causing false caller identification information to appear on a called party's telephone a misdemeanor of the third degree. A second and subsequent offense would be misdemeanors of the second degree. It would not apply to law enforcement agencies, federal intelligence services, and internet service providers under certain circumstances.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
