SUMMARY: House Bill 532 is a freestanding bill known as the Developmentally Disabled Patient Access to Quality Dental Care Act. It would take effect in 180 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation would require every health insurance policy to cover general anesthesia and associated medical costs to patients who are seven years of age or younger or patients who are developmentally disabled.

This Act would not apply to Medical Assistance, which already provides the coverage, as do most health insurance policies in the marketplace.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
