SUMMARY: Amends the “Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code” regarding notice to school districts on proposed residential developments. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation would require municipalities each month to notify in writing the superintendent of a school district in which a development plan received final approval by the municipality in the preceding month. The notice shall include, but is not limited to, the location of the development, the number and types of units to be built, and the expected construction schedule.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds. This legislation would have no adverse impact on local funds.
