#### SUMMARY:

House Bill 915 amends the General Appropriations Act of 2010 by adding appropriations of federal funds.

#### ANALYSIS:

This legislation appropriates \$387,816,000 in federal Education Jobs fund money to be disbursed to school districts through the basic education funding formula for 2010-11. It also increases the federal College Access Challenge Grant Program appropriation to \$4,431,000. This program is jointly administered by the Department of Education and PHEAA.

#### FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no impact on state funds.
