**SUMMARY:** Amends Title 30 (Fish and Boat Code) to change the eligibility requirements which allow certain members of the Armed Forces to receive a fishing license at a reduced fee.

**ANALYSIS:** HB 1236 lowers the active duty service requirement of 180 days to 60 consecutive days for a reduced fee fishing license. This change would allow more members of the Armed Forces to qualify for a \$1 license, including Air National Guard members who operate on a 120 day deployment. The Fish and Boat Commission fully supports this legislation.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** Based on the minimal number of additional reduced fee licenses that would be sold, enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
