**SUMMARY:** Designates the westbound bridge carrying Interstate 90 over Six Mile Creek in Harborcreek Township, Erie County, as the Jarrid L. King Memorial Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation would designate the bridge carrying Interstate 90 over Six Mile Creek in Harborcreek Township, Erie County, as the Jarrid L. King Memorial Bridge.

PennDOT shall erect and maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to traffic in both directions.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost would be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
