SUMMARY: House Bill 1363 amends Sections 1205.1 and 1205.2 concerning continuing professional development. It would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation would suspend, for two years, continuing professional development requirements for certified school teachers and administrators in Pennsylvania. The Department of Education's implementation requirements concerning professional development are suspended as well.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation will be revenue neutral according to the Department of Education. It has the potential to produce savings for school districts as well, with amounts varying by district.
