SUMMARY: This legislation amends the Third Class City Code to provide for promotion procedures for civil service employees. This legislation would take effect immediately and be retroactive to October 19, 2010.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends Section 4406.1 (Promotions) of the Third Class City Code regarding general provisions relating to appointment by the city council to include appointments made by department heads.

The legislation clarifies that the mayor or other elected or appointed officials may continue to make appointments notwithstanding the language of Section 4406.1 (regarding city council appointments from the results of examinations and ranking.)

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds. This legislation will have no adverse impact on funds of 3rd class cities.
