SUMMARY: This legislation amends the First Class Township Code to provide for examinations, background investigations and promotion procedures for civil service police and firemen. This legislation would take effect immediately and be retroactive to October 19, 2010.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends Section 635 of the First Class Township Code regarding general provisions relating to examinations by adding language to:

- Clarify that background investigations of candidates for original appointments may be restricted to those candidates on an eligibility list submitted by the civil service commission or those certified for hiring; and
- Clarify that fitness and agility examinations and medical and psychological examinations may, but need not, be components of promotion examinations.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds. This legislation will have no adverse impact on first class township funds.
