SUMMARY: Exempts from civil liability landowners, including the Commonwealth, who allow their property to be used to conduct an approved, snowmobile and all-terrain vehicle information, safety education and training program for persons under the age of 16. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation would amend Section 7725 (Operation by persons under age sixteen) of Chapter 77 (Snowmobiles and All-Terrain Vehicles) of Title 75 to provide an exemption from civil liability for landowners who allow their property to be used to conduct an approved snowmobile and all-terrain vehicle (ATV) information, safety education and training program for persons under the age of 16.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth or municipal funds.
