SUMMARY: Designates the Uniontown to Brownsville link of State Route 43, beginning with State Route 51 in Uniontown, Fayette County, and ending at State Route 119 in Brownsville, Fayette County, as the POW/ MIA/ KIA Memorial Highway. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation would designate the Uniontown to Brownsville link of State Route 43, beginning with State Route 51 in Uniontown, Fayette County, and ending at State Route 119 in Brownsville, Fayette County, as the POW/ MIA/ KIA Memorial Highway.

PennDOT shall be responsible for the placement and maintenance of signs displaying the designations of this bill.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
