**SUMMARY:** Designates State Route 642, from its intersection with State Route 54 in Montour County to the border of Northumberland and Union Counties, as the United States Army Specialist Zachariah W. Long Highway. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation would designate State Route 642, from its intersection with State Route 54 in Montour County to the border of Northumberland and Union Counties, as the United States Army Specialist Zachariah W. Long Highway.

PennDOT shall erect and maintain appropriate road signs displaying the designated name of the road to traffic in both directions.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
