SUMMARY: Creates special license plates for any person who was in the service of the United States Merchant Marine during World War II. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation would amend Chapter 13 of the Vehicle Code (Title 75) to create a military-related license plate for individuals that served in the United States Merchant Marine during World War II.

PennDOT shall be responsible for issuing the plates, and for requiring the proper documentation from anyone requesting the plates. Each license plate will cost \$20 in addition to the normal annual registration fee.

The plates may be used only on a passenger vehicle or truck with a registered gross weight of not more than 14,000 pounds.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, the cost to design this plate would be \$500. Each plate would cost \$2 to produce. Therefore, it would take the sale of 28 plates to recoup that total cost of \$556.
