**SUMMARY:** House Bill 2004, Printer's Number 2747, amends Title 4 (Amusements) further providing for qualifications and restrictions of Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board members.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation prohibits the following persons from being appointed to the board: (1) an applicant or former applicant; (2) a principal of a licensed entity; or (3) a person with any ownership control in any affiliate, intermediary, subsidiary or holding company thereof. The prohibition does not apply to an individual appointed to the board before July 1, 2010, or an individual who is being reappointed to the board.

The act shall take effect in 60 days.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
