SUMMARY: Designates a portion of PA Route 191 in Washington Township, Northampton County, as the World War II Homefront Heroes Highway. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation would designate PA Route 191 in Washington Township, Northampton County, from the Bangor Borough line to the Plainfield Township line as the World War II Homefront Heroes Highway.

PennDOT shall be responsible for the placement and maintenance of signs displaying the designation of this bill.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
