**SUMMARY:** Amends Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) by authorizing partial waivers of basic training to federal law enforcement officers and military police who have successfully completed equivalent training. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation would amend Title 53 §2164, relating to the powers and duties of the Municipal Police Officers' Education and Training Commission (MPOETC).

The legislation provides that MPOETC has the power to grant partial waivers of mandatory basic training to federal law enforcement officers and military police officers who have successfully completed previous equivalent training. The legislation specifies that federal law enforcement officers and military police officers must fulfill basic police training requirements and meet the minimum standards required for certification.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth or municipal funds.
