**SUMMARY:** House Bill 2168, Printer's Number 3041, amends Section 3102 of Title 51 (Military Affairs) by increasing state active service pay to \$100 per day for the Pennsylvania National Guard. This legislation would take effect immediately upon enactment.

**ANALYSIS:** This bill amends Title 51 (Military Affairs) Section 3102, which establishes the base pay of Pennsylvania National Guard officers and enlisted personnel in active State service or State Active Duty. State Active Duty applies to periods of disasters or emergencies, in a non-federally declared event, when the Pennsylvania National Guard or Pennsylvania Guard is ordered to duty by the Governor as Commander-in-Chief and pay is authorized for such duty.

Officers and enlisted personnel shall be entitled to the same pay and allowances and transportation in kind provided for the current Armed Forces Pay and Allowance Act. The bill increases the State Active Duty pay for Guard personnel from \$75 to \$100 per day.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** Enactment of this legislation is projected to have an additional cost of \$50,000 to Commonwealth funds. This assumes that, on average, 2,000 Guardsmen are activated annually for State Active Duty when responding to non-federally declared emergencies across the Commonwealth such as flooding events and snow storms the past year.
