SUMMARY: Designates a bridge on US Route 202 in Doylestown Township, Bucks County in Honor of First Lieutenant Colby J. Umbrell. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation would designate a bridge carrying US Route 202 over an Unnamed Branch of the Neshaminy Creek in Doylestown Township, Bucks County as the First Lieutenant Colby J. Umbrell Memorial Bridge.

PennDOT shall be responsible for the placement and maintenance of signs displaying the inscription, "In Honor of First Lieutenant Colby J. Umbrell - KIA, Iraq 2007".

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
