SUMMARY: Designates an interchange at the intersection of Route 136 and Interstate 70 as the Officer John David Dryer Memorial Interchange. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation would re-designate the section of highway located at Exit 20 at the intersection of Route 136 and Interstate 70 in Washington County, formerly known as the Beau Street Interchange, as the Officer John David Dryer Memorial Interchange.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying this designation at each end of the bridge.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
