SUMMARY: Provides for a reduced fee for the Gold Star Family specialty license plate and increases the gross vehicle weight of passenger vehicles eligible to be issued this plate to 14,000 pounds. This legislation would take effect in 90 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation would amend Section 1365 of Title 75 (relating to the Gold Star Family license plate) by reducing from \$20 to \$7.50 the administration fee for issuing this plate. That fee is in addition to the annual registration fee.

This legislation would also amend the same section to increase from 10,000 to 14,000 pounds the maximum gross vehicle weight limit for passenger cars and trucks that are eligible to be issued this license plate.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, this legislation would result in the loss of a maximum of \$10,000 in Fiscal Year 2012-13 and the fiscal years thereafter.
